## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) for Road Closures

As delivery partners to Devon County Council we are writing to update you regarding planned road closures for highway works, which are being undertaken to reduce the risk of flooding to properties from surface water during heavy or prolonged rainfall events. The closures are required for the following works:

- Installation of drainage channels across Stoke (School) Road.
- Installation of drainage channel and upgrade of existing drainage infrastructure in Deane Road.
- Reprofiting of the road in Deane Lane and installation of a buddle hole to divert overland flows off of the road.

In order to undertake the works and ensure the safety of local residents, the travelling public and workers on site, three road closures are required as outlined below:

- Stoke (School) Road – 17<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2020
- Deane Lane – 2<sup>nd</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020
- Deane Road – 16<sup>th</sup> March to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2020

The attached plans indicate the location of the closures on Stoke (School) Road, Deane Road and Deane Lane and the associated diversion routes. In the event of a change to the programme we will aim to inform the public, residents and businesses as early as possible.

Advanced signage confirming the dates of each closure will be erected on site at least seven days prior to the closures. Please refer to the website [www.devon.roadworks.org](http://www.devon.roadworks.org) for up to date information in relation to the planned roadworks.

Access to all properties within the road closures will be maintained, as well as access for emergency services. The site team will be in contact with residents or businesses who are directly affected by the closures to discuss continuity of access.

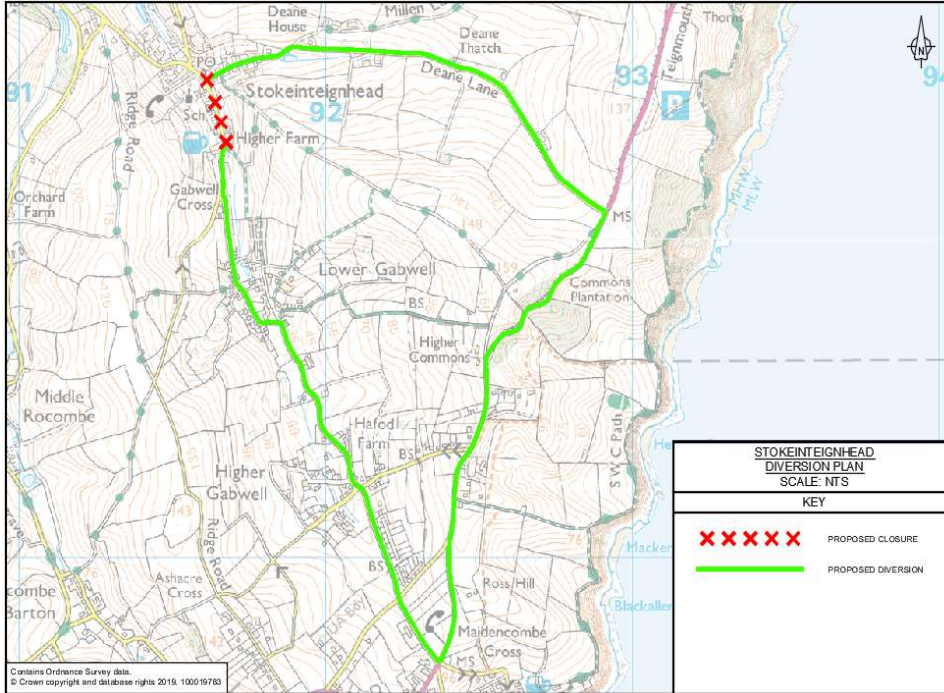

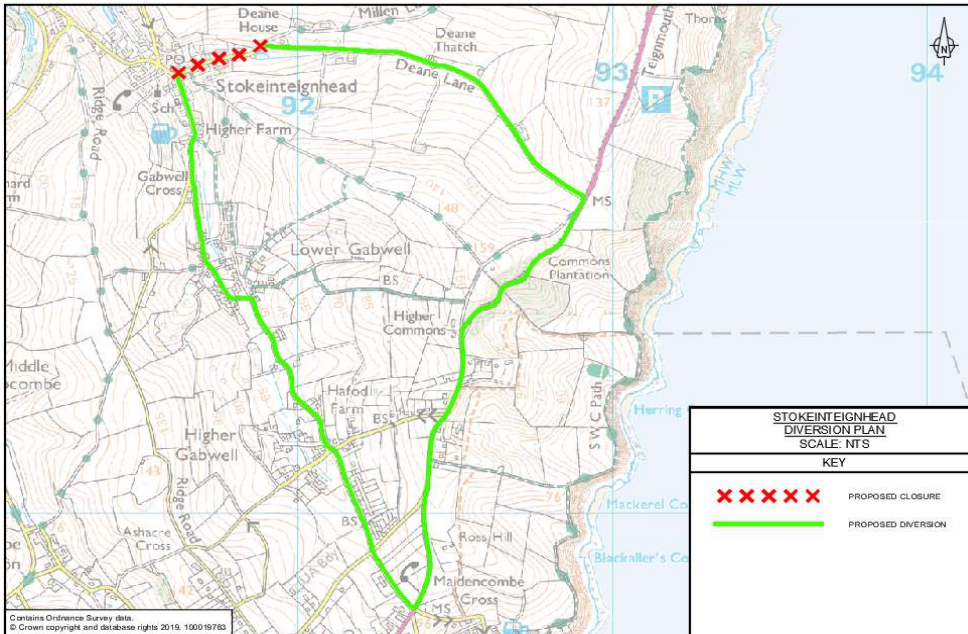
